Subject: Scheme for Modernization of State Police Forces, 2017-18 - Release of Grants-in-aid under Contingency Reserve (HS/HM) to State Governments as per Annexure) for the financial year, 2017-18 under Modernisation of Police Forces.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to convey the sanction of the President for the payment of Grants-in-aid of Rs. 37,67,40,000/- (Rupees thirty seven crore sixty seven lakh and forty thousand only) (as per Annexure) from out of HS/HM Contingency Reserve under the Modernization of State Police Forces Scheme for implementation of Student Police Cadet (SPC) Programme during the financial year 2017-18.

2. The competent authority has also approved that as the above funds have been allocated out of the HS/HM Contingency Reserve the same are not subject to the stipulation of prior liquidation of unspent balances of the previous financial years.

3. The payment of Rs. 37,67,40,000/- (Rupees thirty seven crore sixty seven lakh and forty thousand only) (as per Annexure) may please be released to the State Governments through Reserve Bank of India transfer advice.

4. The expenditure involved is debitible to Major Head 3601 - Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head), 06 - Centrally Sponsored Scheme, 06.101 - Central Assistance/Share (Minor Head), 11- Modernisation of Police Forces, 11.01 - Modernisation of State Police Forces, 11.01.35 Grants for creation of Capital Assets, under Grant No. 48 - Police for the year 2017-18.

5. As per GFR Rule 211(1) the Accounts of all grantee institutions or organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and the IAW of MHA, whenever the institution or organization is called upon to do so.

6. All the terms and conditions stipulated in the Administrative approval of the financial year 2017-18 have been followed.

7. The sanction has been issued with the concurrence of the Ministry's Integrated Finance Division vide CF No. 3399827 dated 24th March, 2018.

2. The State Government is requested to furnish Utilization Certificates sanction-wise and financial year-wise in accordance with form of UC in GFR 19A.


