
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Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to convey the sanction of the President for the payment of Grants-in-aid of Rs. 36,34,70,000/- (Rupees thirty six crore and thirty four lakh seventy thousand only) (as per Annexure ) from out of HS/HM Contingency Reserve under the Scheme for implementation of Student Police Cadet (SPC) Programme Modernization of State Police Forces during the current financial year 2018-19.

2. The competent authority has also approved that as the above funds have been allocated out of the HS/HM Contingency Reserve for meeting exigencies by the State Police forces, the same are not subject to the stipulation of prior liquidation of unspent balances of the previous financial years.
3. The payment of Rs. 36,34,70,000/- (Rupees thirty six crore and thirty four lakh seventy thousand only) (as per Annexure ) may please be released to the State Governments through Reserve Bank of India transfer advice.
4. The expenditure involved is debit to Major Head 3601 - Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head), 06 - Centrally Sponsored Scheme (Sub Major Head), 06.101 - Central Assistance/Share (Minor Head), 11- Modernisation of Police Forces, 11.01 - Modernisation of State Police Forces, 11.01.35 Grants for creation of Capital Assets, under Grant No. 48 - Police for the year 2018-19.
5. As per GFR Rule 211(1) the Accounts of all grantee institutions or organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and the IAW of MHA, whenever the institution or organization is called upon to do so.
6. All the terms and conditions stipulated in the Administrative approval of the financial year 2018-19 have been followed.
7. The sanction has been issued with the concurrence of the Ministry's Integrated Finance Division vide CF No. 326845 dated 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2018.


