Subject: Release of assistance to State Governments from National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF) during 2024-25.

The undersigned is directed to convey the approval of the Competent Authority for release of Rs.5320.80 Lakh (Rupees Fifty Three Crore, Twenty Lakh and Eighty Thousand Only) from NDRF to the following State Governments towards Expansion and Modernization of the Fire Services in the States as per the recommendations of the 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission:

- 2. The above amount is being released to the State Governments based on the recommendation from M/o Home Affairs vide O.Ms. dated  $24^{th}$  and  $27^{th}$  June, 2024.
- 3. RBI may be requested to **credit** the above amount into the account of the State Government immediately.

- 4. The release of funds is governed by the Operational Guidelines for Expansion and Modernization of Fire Services in the States from the earmarked allocation of Preparedness and Capacity Building Funding Window under National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF) based on the recommendations of 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission issued vide Ministry of Home Affairs' letter No.I-45011/9/2020-Ad(CD) dated 4<sup>th</sup> July,2023.
- 5. As approved by High Level Committee (HLC), the funds will be released in three installments of 30%, 40% and 30% of total approved amount subject to utilization of 75% of the previously funds released.
- 6. The State Government(s) will ensure that the utilization of allocated funds is solely for the purpose for which it is released i.e. against the approved project proposal for Expansion and Modernization of Fire Services in the State.
- 7. The above release would follow normal accounting procedure. As such, the amount is to be debited to Major Head-2245-Relief on Account of Natural Calamities, 80-General Relief on Account of Natural Calamity-Assistance to State from National Disaster Response Fund 103.02.00.31 in Demand No.42-Transfers to States.
