The States shall follow all the financial management systems under NHM and shall submit Audit Reports, Utilization Certificates, Quarterly Summary on Concurrent Audit, FMRs/ SOEs and Statement of Funds Position, showing unspent balances, funds released as advances, interest earned on unspent balance as and when due.
- 6. Grant in-aid shall be used for the purpose for which sanction is given. An annual utilization certificate (in Form **GFR 12C**) shall be furnished that the contribution has been utilized for the purpose for which it was sanctioned.

- 7. The sanction order is being issued in accordance with Rule 228 to 245 of General Financial Rules, 2017.
- 8. The expenditure covered by this sanction will be met from the funds provided under Major Head 3601- Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head); 06 Centrally Sponsored Schemes (Sub-Major Head); 102 Externally Aided Projects-Grants for Centally Sponsorred Schemes (Minor Head); 04- Naional Rural Health Mission; 04.01- Flexible Pool for Communicable Diseases; 04.01.31- Grants-in-aid General in Demand No.42 Health & Family Welfare during 2017-18 (Plan).
