**Sub: Grant of assistance to states for strengthening their Enforcement capabilities for combating illicit traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances-Request from the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh**

Sir,

I am directed to convey sanction of the President to the grant of an amount of **Rs.31,43,000/-** (Rupees Thirty One Lac Forty Three Thousand only) to Government of Himachal Pradesh for procuring the items as per details given below to enable them to strengthen and reinforce their capabilities for combating illicit trafficking in Narcotic drugs and Psychotropic Substances. The releases have been restricted to the deduction of the unspent amount of **Rs.9,84,000/-** from the amount of **Rs.41,27,000/-** recommended by the Empowered Committee:

2. The assistance as mentioned above is subject to the criteria laid down in the guidelines of the scheme formulated for the purpose. The amount should be utilized within a period of 12 months from the date of release.

3. States are advised to ensure that there was no overlapping of funds granted under this "Scheme" and any other Schemes which allow the State Government to make purchases of similar items for the stated purpose and objectives of this Scheme i.e. for strengthening the enforcement capabilities in combating illicit trafficking in narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances.

4. The expenditure involved is debitable to Grant No. 48- Police, Major Head 3601-Grants-in-aid to State Government, 01- Non-Plan Grants, 01.117-Police-other Grants, 04 Narcotics Control Bureau to cover gap in resource, 04.00.31-Grants-in aid General for the year 2016-17.

5. The Utilization Certificate alongwith the Audit Certificate for the above releases on this subject should be sent by the state Government as soon as possible in the prescribed proforma as per GFR.
