Sub: Grant of assistance to states for strengthening their Enforcement capabilities for combating illicit traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances - Request from the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh for the year 2020-21.

Sir,

I am directed to convey sanction of the competent authority to the grant of an amount of **Rs. 2,82,711/- (Rupees Two Lakh eighty Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Eleven only)** to Government of Himachal Pradesh for procuring the items as per scheme to enable them to strengthen and reinforce their capabilities for combating illicit trafficking in Narcotic drugs and Psychotropic Substances (ANNEXURE-A). The releases have been restricted to the deduction of the unspent amount of **Rs. 57,289/-** from the amount of **Rs. 3,40,000/-** recommended by the Empowered Committee.

2. State is advised to ensure that there was no overlapping of funds granted under this "Scheme" and any other Schemes which allow the State Government to make purchases of similar items for the above stated purpose and objectives of this Scheme i.e. for strengthening the enforcement capabilities in combating illicit trafficking in narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances.

3. The sanction is subjected to following conditions:

- a) Adherence to all codal formalities and follow the provisions of GFRs-2017 at all stages.
- b) To follow the instruction of DoE regarding expenditure.
- c) It was also advised that States shall provide UCs and adopt EAT module/PFMS at the earliest.

4. The assistance as mentioned above is subject to the criteria laid down in the guidelines of the scheme formulated for the purpose. The release amount should be utilized within a period of 12 months from the date of release.

5. The Utilization Certificate along with the Audit Certificate for the above release on this subject should be sent by the state Government as soon as possible in the prescribed proforma as per GFR.
6. This issues with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division of MHA conveyed vide their Dy. No. 3511551/E.IV dated 24.03.2021 and administrative approval of the competent authority conveyed vide their DY. No. 3511551 dated 25.03.2021.
7. The Payment of Rs. 2.82,711/- (Rupees Two Lakh eighty Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Eleven only) may please be released to the Government of Himachal Pradesh through Reserve Bank of India on transfer advice..
8. The Expenditure involved is debitible under Grant No.48-Police the Major Head 3601, Sub Major Head - 08, Minor Head - 08.110, Object Head - 01.00.35 - Grant for Creation of Capital Assets under the scheme "Assistance to States & UTs for Narcotics Control" for the financial year 2020-21.
