**Sub: Release of funds for setting up of Fast Track Special Courts (FTSCs) in Himachal Pradesh**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Himachal Pradesh Government's letter no. Home-B.D(1)/1/2018, dated 19.12.2019 (copy enclosed) on the above subject and to convey the sanction of the President for release of an amount of Rs.0.16875 crore (Rupees Sixteen lakh eighty seven thousand and five hundred only) as first installment to the State of Himachal Pradesh for setting up of three Fast Track Special Courts in Himachal Pradesh as per the following details:

2. Due to late joining, as of now only token money for one month is being released. However the Scheme will be valid for a year. The balance funds for this FY will be released on receipt of additional funds under Nirbhaya Fund.

The expenditure involved is debitable to Demand No.63 from Nirbhaya Fund under the Major Head 3601 - Grant-in-Aid to State Government- 06 Centrally Sponsored Scheme- 101 Central Assistance/Share - 69 National Mission for Safety of Women (Nirbhaya Fund) 01.31 Grant-in-Aid General (3601.06.101.69.01.31) for the year 2019-20.

4. The accounts of the State Government in respect of the Grants being released shall be open to inspection by the Sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Account Office of the Department of Justice, whenever the State Government is called upon to do so.

5. The sanction has been entered in the Register of Grants at Serial No. 26 at page No. 15.
