It is requested that arrangement may kindly be made to credit this amount to the State Governments/UTs in accordance with the procedure laid down in the Ministry of Finance vide their O.M.No.2(45) 76-Spl.Cell dated 30.08.1976 as modified vide their O.M. even number dated 16.9.1976 under intimation to this Ministry.

4. This sanction issues with the concurrence of the Integrated Finance Division vide their Dy.No.27728/JS&FA dated 11.03.2019.

5. The payee has no Utilization Certificate as due for rendition under the Rule under this scheme of the Ministry.

6. The State Government will maintain separate accounts in respect of the grant-in-aid received under the scheme. The accounts will remain open for inspection by the representatives of the officers from the Office of Comptroller and Auditor General of India/Government of India The State Govt. will have the accounts of the grant-in-aid audited by the Govt. Auditor and shall furnish the Utilization Certificate in the prescribed format in GFR-12-C in original duly signed by authorized signatory of the State Govt.


