I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the payment of **₹20,05,50,000/- (Rupees Twenty Crore Five Lakh and Fifty Thousand only)** as **2<sup>nd</sup> installment of grants-in-aid during 2024-25** towards GOI's share on Supplementary Nutrition Programme based on number of aadhaar verified beneficiaries on Poshan Tracker as on 31.03.2024 for continued implementation of Anganwadi Services (General Component) to the States as indicated below:

2. Supplementary Nutrition Programme (SNP) is a DBT Scheme and States/UTs are mandated to implement SNP strictly in DBT mode w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2018 in terms of notification issued under the Aadhaar Act, 2016. Accordingly, States/UTs are required to take following action:

- (i) Authentication of all beneficiaries using Aadhaar as primary identifier;
- (ii) Follow exception handling mechanism for beneficiaries not having Aadhaar;
- (iii) Ensure that no genuine beneficiary is denied of the benefits and services for not possessing Aadhaar; and
- (iv) Eliminate ghost/fake beneficiaries from the system by head count or Aadhaar authentication.

3. Anganwadi Services Scheme is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme in which the Centre and States/UTs both have contributions. In the above release, the Centre contributions have been calculated on **90:10** ratio between Centre and States and the sanction of funds is subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The amount of grant will have to be utilized for all the components under the Scheme as per the schematic norms; and
- (ii) The States/UTs shall also be required to contribute adequate amount for implementation of the Anganwadi Services Scheme

4. The sanction of funds is also contingent upon States/UTs ensuring e-procurement of goods and services under Anganwadi Services Scheme. The advisory in this regard has already been issued to all States/UTs vide circular No.19-37/2015-CD-I, dated 09.07.2015.

8. The States/UTs shall maintain separate accounts and furnish information on actual expenditure incurred on Supplementary Nutrition Programme every quarter. The information on expenditure on Supplementary Nutrition Programme from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> June must be furnished by 15<sup>th</sup> July and for the period from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> September by 15<sup>th</sup> October and from the period 1<sup>st</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> December by 15<sup>th</sup> January and from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> March by 15<sup>th</sup> April to enable the Ministry to work out the entitlement of Central assistance of the State Government/UT Administration.
