Thirty Six Lakhs only) as grant-in-aid to the States of Bihar, Himachal Pradesh and Mizoram under the project Cyber Crime Prevention Against Women and Children (CCPWC) for outsourcing manpower (One Jr. Cyber Forensic Consultant) during financial year 2020-21.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for the payment of Rs.36,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Six Lakhs only) as grant-in-aid to the following States for the purpose of outsourcing manpower (One Jr. Cyber Forensic Consultant) towards implementation of the project 'Cyber Crime Prevention Against Women and Children (CCPWC)' during financial year 2020-21 as per following break up:-

2. The above amounts will be sent through RBI Advisory to the Government of these States.

3. The expenditure involved in this Sanction is debatable to Demand No.48 Police; 3601-Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head); 08.111 Special Assistance (Minor Head); 06- Schemes Financed from Nirbhaya Fund; 06.02 – Grants for Cyber Crime Prevention against Women and Children; 06.02.31 – Grants-in-aid- General during the year 2020-2021.


4. The detailed instructions regarding utilization of the grant-in-aid, amount for capacity building training to police officers, judicial officers and judicial prosecutors will be imparted as per letter No.22006/2/17-CIS-II dated 02.02.2018 issued by this Ministry. The grantee shall ensure that the disbursed funds are utilized as per the norms and GFR codal formalities, and should not lead to parking of funds. The State implementing agency is required to submit Utilization Certificate for the amount released under this Head in the prescribed pro-forma on due date to Ministry of Home Affairs.

5. As per GFR 211(1) of accounts of all grantees shall be made open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and the Internal Audit Wing of MHA, whenever the grantees are called upon to do so.

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6. The grant may be released to the respective State Governments immediately.
7. The sanction issues with the concurrence of IFD vide their Dy. No.3418684 dated 19.03.2021 and with the approval of the competent authority.
