- The amount of above loan is the 1st installment of loan towards capital project for the 'Construction of Unity Mall' at Daghwar, Tehsil Dharamshala, District Kangra, Himachal Pradesh, communicated vide Department of Expenditure's (DoE's) O.M No. 44(1)/PF-S/(CAPEX)-Part-VI/2023-24 dated 10.11.2023 to Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) and State Government of Himachal Pradesh under Part-VI (Construction of Unity Malls) of the 'Scheme for Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment for 2023-24' and is being released based on the recommendation received from DPIIT vide O.M. No. P-25020/23/2023-EODB Section-Part (1) dated 30.10.2023 and the scheme guidelines issued in respect of Part-VI of the Scheme by DoE vide letters No. 44(1)/PF-S/2023-24(CAPEX) dated 03.02.2023, 16.06.2023, subject to the following conditions:
 - The amount of loan under Part-VI of the Scheme is earmarked for the capital project for the 'Construction of Unity Mall' in the State of Himachal Pradesh approved under Part-VI of the Scheme and communicated to DPIIT vide O.M No. 44(1)/PF-S/(CAPEX)-Part-VI/2023-24 dated 10.11.2023 and State Government of Himachal Pradesh.
 - Violations of conditions detailed in Para(3)(vi) of the scheme guidelines issued vide letter No. 44 (1)/PF-S/2023-24 (CAPEX) dated 03.02.2023 and in supplementary guidelines for Part-VI issued vide letter No. 44 (1)/PF-S/2023-24 (CAPEX) dated 16.06.2023, will result in the deduction of amounts by the Government of India from devolution of taxes to the State.
 - State will notify a SASCI nodal agency for implementing Part VI of the Scheme. The nodal iii. agency will open a savings account in a scheduled commercial bank and will onboard the same on PFMS.
 - The amount released by the Union Government shall be released to the SASCI nodal iv. agency (being the implementing agency for this Part of the Scheme) of the State Government within 10 working days.
 - State shall submit a progress report of the capital project approved under Part-VI of the Scheme for 2023-24, to DPIIT in order to avail the 2nd installment of loan under this Part.
 - The State Government shall ensure that there is no duplication in funding of the capital vi. projects approved under the Scheme either with the funds provided by the Government of India or the State Government.

- vii. In case of unavoidable changes in the project for which funds are being released, the State Government shall seek the approval of the Government of India for the change. Funds will not be provided in case of un-approved changes.
- viii. Expenditure by the State of the funds provided under the Scheme, for purposes other than for which the funds were sanctioned, will result in the deduction of the amounts by the Government of India from the devolution of the taxes to the State.
- ix. All provisions of the guidelines of the Scheme issued vide letters no. 44(1)/PF-S/2023-24 (CAPEX) dated 03.02.2023, 02.05.2023, 19.05.2023, 26.05.2023, 16.06.2023, 19.06.2023, 31.07.2023, 11.10.2023 and 19.10.2023 shall be applicable in toto and shall be strictly adhered to by the State Government of Himachal Pradesh and its implementing agencies.
- x. Violations of mandatory conditions detailed in Para (4)(ii) and Para 4(iii) of the scheme guidelines issued vide letters no. 44(1)/PF-S/2023-24(CAPEX) dated 03.02.2023 and 19.05.2023 will result in the deduction of amounts by the Government of India from devolution of taxes to the State.
