- 3. The expenditure to be incurred is subject to the following terms and condition:-
- (i) The grants shall be utilized by the concerned implementing agency in accordance with the operational guidelines of the scheme "Soil Health Card" of National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture" (guidelines is available at DAC website: www.agricoop.nic.in).

(ii) Financial assistance for various components shall be allowed as per cost norms in the operational guidelines of Soil Health Card scheme on 90: 10 sharing pattern between Govt. of India and State Government.

(iii) The matching state share corresponding to the central share may also be released as per guidelines. The physical and financial breakup for the activities to be taken up for the total grant released during the financial year including both Central and State share is given in Annexure.

- The implementing agency shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure (iv) incurred and submit the statement of Audited accounts and utilization certificate to this Department as soon as possible along with progress report after close of the financial year. - (viii) Revalidated amount of interest earned and unspent fund will be adjusted against future releases of first/second installment and allocation of current financial year will be reduced to that extent. (ix) Balance Sheet and
