- 5. I am directed to convey the sanction of President of India to the payment of Rs. 717.68 lakhs (Rupees Seven Crore Seventeen Lakh and Sixty Eight Thousand only) under General Head to the Government of Himachal Pradesh as 1st installment of Recurring Central Assistance to meet the expenditure in respect of DIETs, CTE & SCERT under the Scheme of Teacher Education.
- The amount sanctioned under SCSP Head is being issued separately.
- The above grant of Central assistance shall be subject to the following conditions:-
- (i) Central assistance will be utilized in conformity with the guidelines for the scheme circulated to State Governments vide this Department's D.O. letter No.44-2/2012-EE-9, dated 12.07.2012, and any other guidelines that may be circulated by the Deptt. from time to time.
- (ii) Expenditure on the training programme under other specific schemes (like SSA, EGS/AIE, etc.), shall be met from the funds sanctioned under those schemes and not from the funds sanctioned under Teacher Education Scheme.
- (iii) A copy of every order of State Government according administrative approval or financial sanction for any item of recurring expenditure (including orders concerning posts) in connection with the above institutions will be endorsed to this Department.
- State Government shall abide by the terms & conditions of the MOU executed by the Ministry and the State Government, and any further guidelines which may be issued by the Ministry from time to time.
- (v) The amount of grant shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and unspent balance out of the grant, if any, at the end of 2016-17, shall be refunded by the State Government after the close of the financial year unless permission is granted for its being carried forward for utilization for the same purpose during the following financial year.

- (vi) State Govt. shall regularly submit half-yearly progress cum utilization report under the Teacher Education Scheme. Utilization report of amount being released by this sanction letter shall be forwarded by the State Govt. at the earliest and in any case within three months from close of the financial year.
 - (vii) Accounts of all grantee institutions shall be made available for inspection by the sanctioning authority for audit whenever asked to do so.
 - (viii) The accounts of all grantee Institutions or Organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organization is called upon to do so and a provision to this effect should invariably be incorporated in all orders sanctioning grants-in-aid.
 - Expenditure of Rs. 717.68 lakhs (Rupees Seven Crore Seventeen Lakh and Sixty Eight Thousand only) will be debited to Demand No. 51-Department of School Education and Literacy, 3601-Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head), 02-Grants for State Plan Schemes (Sub Major Head), 188-Elementary Education-Teachers Training (Minor Head), 02-National Education Mission-Teachers Training (Sub Head), 01-Strengthening of Teacher Training Institutions, 02.01.31-Grants-in-aid General 2016-17.
 - The pattern of grant/expenditure has been approved by the Ministry of Finance. This sanction is being issued in conformity with rules and principles of the Scheme as approved by the Ministry of Finance.
 - 10. On receipt of the sanction letter, the Principal Accounts Officer may issue an advice to the Reserve Bank of India (Central Accounts Section), Nagpur for accrual of credit balance to the State Government. The Principal Accounts Officer may forward a copy of the advice to the Accountant General and Finance Department of the Government of Himachal Pradesh along with a copy to the undersigned.
 - The grantee is located in Himachal Pradesh Circle of Accounts.
