Subject: Sanction for financial assistance to **Government of Himachal Pradesh**, as Grant-in-aid under the centrally sponsored scheme "Capacity Development for developing Trauma Care Facilities in Government Hospitals located on National Highways" during 12th Five Year Plan – reg.

Sir,

In supersession of this Ministry's Sanction letter of even number dated 5th May 2017, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the payment of **Rs. 12,60,00,000/- (Rupees twelve Crores sixty Lac only)** as release of 1st installment from the Central Share towards construction and procurement of equipments for up-gradation and strengthening of emergency facilities at **IGMC Govt. Hospital, Shimla, Himachal Pradesh (L-I)** under the Scheme of "Capacity Building for Developing Trauma Care Facilities in Government in National Highway".

2. The expenditure involved will be met from the Demand No. 42 – Department of Health & Family Welfare; (Major Head) 3601 – Grant-in-aid to State Governments; (Minor Head) 06101 – Central Assistance/Share; (Sub Head) 2102 – Assistance for Capacity Building for Trauma Centres-Injury & Trauma Care; (Object Head) 35 – Grants for creation of Capital Assets (New) – Plan for the financial year 2017-18.

3. The accounts of the Grantee Institutions shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and will also be liable for statutory audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India as per the norms of General Financial Rules.


4. The grant-in-aid is subject to the following:-

- (i) The funds may be deposited in already opened Bank Account for the purpose. **Interest earned should be credited into Government of India account as revenue.**
- (ii) The funds sanctioned will be utilized for the purpose for which it is sanctioned;
- (iii) The State Government may place order for procurement of high value equipments approved for Level I Trauma Care Facility, through its own agency following the due process of procurement as laid down in **GFR-2017**. A List of equipment so procured may be sent to this Ministry.

- (iv) Further release of funds will be made after following conditions are met:
- Progress on construction and purchase of equipment (Desirable to complete construction of building within one and half year and procurement along with installation of equipment within 2 years of release of grants by GOI).
 - Statement of Expenditure and Utilization Certificate duly audited by the State Accountant General and audited accounts be submitted to this Ministry within 12 months of release of funds;
- (v) The **Government of Himachal Pradesh** will furnish an undertaking to bear the additional expenditure, if any, on account of salary of the staff, their training and maintenance of equipment etc. to be procured under the scheme;
- (vi) A certificate regarding satisfactory completion of the process of procurement and installation of equipments may be sent to this Ministry;
- (vii) A quarterly progress report for implementation of the project and audited utilization certificate and Statement of Expenditure may be sent to Programme Division (Trauma & Burn) MoHFW/Dte.GHS by the Institutes concerned.
- (viii) After receipt of such a certificate inspection of the trauma care facility will be carried out by the officials of the Ministry / Dte. General of Health Service; and
- (ix) This shall be subject to fulfillment of various terms and conditions specified and mutually agreed upon in the MOU.
5. This sanction has been issued as per **Rule 228-245 of General Financial Rule (GFR), 2017.**
6. The sanction of above grant is subject to production of Audited UC & SOE as soon as the Audit is conducted by the State.
7. This issues with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division of this Ministry vide their **Dy. No. C-327 dated 2nd May, 2017.**
