**ORDER:**

The 13<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission, among other schemes under Grants-in-aid has recommended a sum of Rs.252.44 crores (for 5 years i.e. 2010-2015) to Tamil Nadu for Improvement in Justice Delivery, of which, a sum of Rs.40.76 crores has been recommended for construction of Alternate Disputes Resolution Centres and to provide training to Mediators, Judicial Officers, etc. for the period 2010-2015.

2. In accordance with the guidelines issued by the Government of India for utilization of the Grants-in-aid, the High Court of Madras has constituted a Monitoring Committee with a view to ensure that the projects are successfully implemented and based on the decision taken by the Monitoring Committee on the above said schemes the Registrar General, High Court, Madras, has sent the proposal in respect of training to Mediators, Judicial Officers and Advocates in the Mediation. to the Government. The Registrar General, in his proposal has stated that an amount of Rs.40.76 crores was allotted to the State of Tamil Nadu under the head, 'Alternate Disputes Resolution (ADR) Centre'. After earmarking Rs.30.00 crores for putting up Alternate Disputes Resolution Centres in all 30 Judicial Districts in the State, the remaining amount of Rs.10.76 crores is decided to be spent for the purpose of giving specialized training to the Mediators, Judicial Officers and Advocates in Mediation.

3. The High Level Monitoring Committee, has approved the proposal, for construction of 30 Alternate Disputes Resolution Centres at a cost of Rs.1.00 Crore each for which type design will be evolved by Public Works Department with the approval of the High Court and for entrusting the job of provision of specialized training to the Mediators, Judicial Officers, and Advocates in Mediation at a cost of Rs.10.76 crores to Tamil Nadu State Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court Buildings, High Court, through the Registrar General, High Court, Chennai. The Committee further approved that the funds be placed at the disposal of the Registrar General, High Court, Madras.

4. Accordingly, the Government after careful examination of the above proposal decided to accept it and accord administrative sanction of Rs.10.76 crores (Rupees Ten crores and seventy six lakhs only) for entrusting the job of provision of specialized training to the Mediators, Judicial Officers and Advocates in Mediation for the period 2010-2015 and financial sanction of Rs.107.60 lakhs (Rupees one crore seven lakhs and sixty thousand only) for the year 2010-11 towards the scheme viz., entrusting the job of provision of specialized training to the Mediators, Judicial Officers and Advocates in Mediation against the total outlay of Rs.10.76 Crores to Tamil Nadu State Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court Buildings through the Registrar General, High Court, Madras, The Government also direct that the funds be placed at the disposal of the Registrar General, High Court, Madras. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to take necessary immediate action in the matter.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following new head of account opened under Demand No.03-01:-

"2014.00 Administration of Justice - 800 other expenditure - I Non Plan - AN. Establishment of Alternate Dispute Resolution Centres by using 13<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission Grant -72 Training (DPC 2014.00 800 AN - 7207)"

6. The Registrar General, High Court / Member Secretary, Tamil Nadu State Legal Services Chennai Authority, is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling Authority for the above new head of Account.

7. The Pay and Accounts Officer's / Treasury Officer's concerned are requested to open this new head of Account in this Accounts.

8. Necessary funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2010-2011. Pending provision of such funds in RE/FMA 2010-2011 the Registrar General, High Court, Chennai is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above. The Registrar General, High Court, Chennai is also requested to include the above expenditure while sending the proposal for RE/FMA 2010-11 to Government at the appropriate time without fail.

9. However, the above expenditure shall be brought to the notice of legislature by a specific inclusion in Supplementary Estimate 2010-2011. He is also requested to send necessary draft explanatory note for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2010-2011.

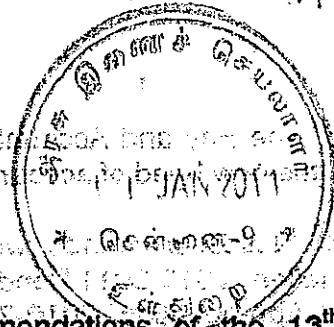

**ORDER:-**

The Thirteenth Finance Commission has recommended Grants – in – aid of Rs. 252.44 crore to the State of Tamil Nadu towards the scheme "Improvement in Justice Delivery". Based on the recommendation towards the above scheme, the Government of India has released a sum of Rs.25.2430 crore as first Installment grant-in-aid for the year 2010-2011. Out of Rs.252.44 crore Grants-in-aid, the Thirteenth Finance Commission has also recommended Grants-in-aid of Rs.12.35 crore for giving training to the Judicial Officers. In this connection, a High Level Monitoring Committee was constituted for this purpose under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government and the committee in its meeting held on 16.11.2010 has approved a sum of Rs.2.47 crore to the Tamil Nadu State Judicial Academy for giving training to the Judicial Officers for the year 2010-2011.

2. Taking into consideration of the decision of High Level Monitoring Committee, the Government accord sanction for a sum of Rs.2,47,00,000/- (Rupees two crore and forty seven lakhs only) for giving training to the Judicial Officers through State Judicial Academy.

3. The expenditure sanctioned in para-2 above shall be debited under the following head of account.
