Subject:- Regarding criminal cases.


Sir/Madam,

On the subject cited above I am directed to say that it has been observed that criminal cases in those the approval for withdrawn from prosecution have already been given are being sent by the District Magistrates to Government again for according approval/decision for filing of an appeals/revisions.

It is quite obvious that when a decision has been conveyed for the withdrawal, there appears no question to send the cases to Government again. Further it has also been noticed that cases under section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act are also being sent which are not required to be decided at the Government level, as the disputes u/s 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act are between the parties and purely a private matter, where the State has nothing to do.

It is, therefore, requested to ensure the compliance of above instructions.
