NOTIFICATION

Consequent upon the selection of Shri Rajesh Kumar Dharmani, HPPS, S.P., PTC, Daroh, Distt. Kangra, H.P. with UN Mission in South Sudan (UNMISS), the Governor, Himachal Pradesh, is pleased to relieve him and place his services at the disposal of U.N. Mission in South Sudan facilitating him to take up his assignment on deployment basis, with immediate effect, in public interest. The Officer will report to Commandant, National UN CIVPOL Centre, 22nd Bn. ITBP, New Delhi by 30th May, 2016 for completion of pre-departure formalities and further deployment with UN Mission in South Sudan on following terms and conditions:-

1. The Deployment will commence from 5th June, 2015 and will be for one year only.
2. The initial approved period of deployment will be treated as "Duty" for which pay and allowances shall be borne by the State Government; and after deployment of one year, if any extension is given, then that shall be treated as "extra ordinary leave" without pay which will count for pension as a special case. Therefore, He will draw full pay and allowances which he would have been drawn, had he remained on duty in India, subject to the production of certificate to this effect prescribed in para-8(d) under Rule-6 (C) of F.R.S.R. Part-V. He will draw pay in rupees in India and no part thereof be allowed to be drawn in foreign exchange. The salary will be paid by the State Government as per terms and conditions fixed by the Government of India, MHA, New Delhi. The officer may also be allowed to retain Government accommodation/telephone etc, if any, held by him.
3. The cost of uniform will be borne by the officer concerned during above Mission.
4. The UN only pays subsistence allowance during the period of deployment within UN Mission area. The Pay and allowances are to be paid by the lending authority.
5. The Contribution towards leave salary and pension is not required to be paid either by the borrowing authority or by the officer concerned.
