

Awareness about right of the Prisoners and Corresponding Duties of the Jail Custodians/Authority

To organize Legal Awareness Programme on monthly basis for sensitization of Prisoners/Convicts through Video Conferencing or any other digital modes on the following topics:

- Rights of Prisoners and corresponding duties of the Jail custodians in ensuring the protection of their rights
 - Plea bargaining
 - Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) issued by NALSA
 - Parole
 - Furlough

- Through Video Conferencing or any other digital modes, DLSAs may interact with all the jail inmates, convicts/under trials and provide them immediate legal aid/assistance as may be required for filling appeal or seeking bail, premature release, furlough, parole, etc.
 - DLSAs may also take up the matter with the concerned Authorities of their respective District to expedite the application(s) of parole, premature release, furlough, etc. of jail inmates/convicts, if any pending with them.
 - To coordinate with Jail Superintendent of their respective Districts to solve grievance(s) of jail inmates, convicts/under trials with regard to health both physiological & psychological, educational opportunities and overall well-being of prisoners, medical facilities, hygiene, cleanliness, timely payment dues of inmates, parole, furlough, beddings, video conferencing facilities, drinking water, sanitation, safety of inmates, condition in barracks, overcrowding, healthcare etc.
 - If during video conferencing, any matter is raised by any of the jail inmates/convicts/under trials, the same be properly addressed by providing immediate legal aid/advise or legal assistance as the case may be.
 - The services of Retainer Lawyers, Para Legal Volunteers and Jail Visiting Counsels be utilized fortnightly or as per the requirement during existent COVID-19 Pandemic situation.
