Sports Council has decided to revise the Awards to outstanding sportspersons Rules with a view to give enhanced incentive to the sportspersons of the state as per Annexure-A and Schedule enclosed herewith. The Awards to outstanding sportspersons Rules, 2013-14 are also amended as per enclosed schedule.

These amended Rules will come into force from the year 2016-17 onwards.

DA/ Annexure- A & Schedule

HIMACHAL PRADESH SPORTS COUNCIL

- These rules shall be known as 'Awards to outstanding sportspersons' Rules 2013-14 reamended in year 2016-17.
- 2. For the purpose of these rules;
- a) "International sports competitions" shall mean Olympic Games, Asian Games, Common Wealth Games.
- b) "National Sports Competitions" shall mean National Sports Championship/ meet recognized as such by the respective National Federation of the Game/ sport.
- c) "Inter University Sports Tournament" shall mean a tournament between the various universities and recognized as such by the Association of Indian Universities.
- d) "National School Games" shall mean an inter- state tournament recognized by the School Games Federation of India.
- e) "Departmental sports competition" shall mean an inter- state Sports Championship/ meet among employees of the Central/ State Government/ or other autonomous organization / undertaking controlled by the Central/ State Government.
- f) "Council" shall mean Himachal Pradesh Sports Council.
- g) "Sportspersons" shall include sportsmen and sports women.
- Only sportspersons who belong to Himachal Pradesh and who are sponsored by the
 respective state sports association to take part in sports competitions as part of the
 Himachal Pradesh contingent shall be eligible for these awards.
- 4. These awards will be given on the basis of the calendar year.
- Cash prizes will be awarded to sportspersons who achieve distinction in sports competitions in accordance with the rates for different categories specified in the schedule.

Provided that if an individual gets positions in different events of the same game/ sports, he or she shall be entitled to the full amount of the highest prize and 50% of the amount of the other prize(s) to which he/she is entitled. These cash awards will primarily be meant to augment their diet requirement.

- Whenever any sportsperson establishes a new International record in any individual event, he/she shall be entitled to cash prizes of Rs. 10,00,000/-.
- Whenever any sportspersons establishes a new Asian/ Commonwealth record in any individual event, he/ she shall be entitled to a cash prize of Rs. 10,00,000/-.
- Whenever any sportspersons establishes a new National record in any individual event, he/ she shall be entitled to a cash prize of Rs. 5,00,000/- each time.
- Whenever a sportsperson participates in any international sports Competition as a member of the Indian contingent he/ she shall be entitled to a cash prize of Rs 1,00,000/-.

- 10. All Sportspersons securing awards in group-A of the schedule or under rules 6,7,8,9, of these rules will be entitled to an additional prize of Rs. 2,00,000/- along with a replica of the Parshuram statue. Provided that the State Parshuram award will be given only once to a sportsperson.
- 11. All sportsperson representing H.P. and who secure first or second position in individual events/ team game in any senior level National Sports competition or who represent H.P. in any Senior level National Sports competition consecutively for 5 years out of which the individual/team has reached the semi finals at least once during this period will also be eligible for the Parshuram Award under Rule-10.
- The council shall constitute a Committee to be called the Awards Committee to examine
 the authenticity of the distinctions achieved by sportspersons and their eligibility or
 otherwise for these Awards.
- The Secretary, in accordance with the recommendations of the Awards Committee and with the approval of the President, shall disburse the prizes out of Department/ Council Funds.
- These Awards shall not be claimed as a matter of right and the decision of the Council shall be final and binding.
- 15. New addition to the Rules:

The Council reserves the right to amend, alter, delete or add to any of the preferences of these Rules at any time without assigning any reasons.
