NOTIFICATION

In exercise of powers conferred by section 15 of Memorandum of Association of H.P Sports Council, the President Himachal Pradesh Sports Council in pursuant to Himachal Pradesh Swarnim Jayanti Sports Policy 2021 and subsequent Notification No.YSS-F(1)-1/2019-Part-I- Loose dated 7th June, 2024 and dated 27th June, 2024 is pleased to make the following rules known as "Cash Awards to Medal Winners and their coaches."

Short-title and commencement.

- (i) These rules may be called the Himachal Pradesh Sports Council" Cash Award to Medal Winner and their coaches" Rules, 2024.
- (ii) These rules shall come into force w.e.f 20th January, 2022 the date of Notification of Himachal Pradesh Swarnim Jayanti Sports Policy 2021.
- 2. Definitions:- In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - "International sports competitions" shall mean Summer Olympics/ Winter Olympics/ Paralympics Games, Asian Games/Para Asian Games, and Common Wealth Games / Para Commonwealth Games.
 - World Cups/World Championships/Para World Games shall mean events (Only Olympic) organized once in four years.
 - iii) "National Sports Competitions" shall mean National Sports Championship/ meet recognized as such by the respective National Federation of the Game /sport.
 - iv) "Inter University Sports Tournament "shall mean a tournament between the various universities and recognizes as such by the Association of Indian Universities.
 - v) "National School Games" shall mean an inter-state tournament recognizes by the School Games Federation of India.
 - vi) "Council" shall mean Himachal Pradesh Sports Council.
 - viii) "Sportsperson shall include sportsmen and sports women of Himachal Pradesh.
 - 3. Eligibility:- only sportspersons (s) who belong (s) to Himachal Pradesh and who are sponsored by the respective state sports association to take part in Sports competitions as part of the Himachal Pradesh contingent shall be eligible for Cash Award.
 - 4. Frequency of Award: Cash Award will be given on the basis of the calendar year.

- Amount of Award:- The Cash Prize will be awarded to sportspersons who achieve distinction in sports competitions in accordance with the rates for different categories specified in the <u>Schedule-I.</u>
 - In case of Himachali players being part of the winning team in a team event, (International level) will be given the prize money, in proportion of the representation.
 - The cash prizes as mentioned in <u>Schedule-I</u> are for medal winners in National level individual events. For team events individual players will be paid 30% amount meant for individual medal winning players.
- Prize Money meant for Coaches will be divided between coaches involved at various levels as per guidelines fixed by SAI from time to time and modified with state perspective.
- 6. Incentive to coaches:- The amount of cash award payable to coaches of medal winners in individual events will be distributed among the following types of coaches in the ratio mentioned against each category:
 - (i) Coach at grass root level who initially spotted the talent and groomed: 30% of the amount payable to the Coaches.
 - (ii) Coach at the developmental level who further groomed and nurtured the medal winning sportsperson which would also include personal coach: 30% of the amount payable to the coaches.
 - (iii) Coach at the elite level who have been part of the coaching campus or imparted training to the medal winner for at least 180 days in the preceding two year period before the event: 40% the amount payable to coach(es)
 - (iv) Names for coach at grassroot level and coach at the development level will be as recommended by the medal winning sportsperson. However spouse, further mother, brother and sister of the sportspersons will not eligible for cash award in these cases.
 - (v) For the Coach(es) at the elite level who have been part of the coaching campus of imparted training to the medal winner for at least 180 days in the preceding two year period before the event, the set of coaches could comprise of 1 or more coaches. In case, the set contains more than coach, the award money will be distributed among all the coaches in the set, equally.
 - (vi) The Cash Award for the Coaches) at the elite level will be given regardless of whether a coach is a Chief coach or Assistant Coach subject to the condition that the coach should have been associated with the training of the athlete / team on a regular basis for at least a minimum period of 180 days. i.e each coach in the set of coaches should have been associated with the medal winning sportsperson/team for at least 180 days on a regular basis.

- (vii) For team event the prize money meant for coaches will be divided equally between coaches involved at various levels
- Claim for Award:- The HP State sports associations: university administration and department of Education will submit the detail of medal winners at National & International level with in one month from the event.
- 8. Application for the award:- The proposal for cash Award in the prescribed format (Annexure I &II) from the medal winning sportsperson (s) /coaches along with attested Xerox copies of the certificate of winning medals wherever such certificates are issued by the organizer of the sports events and achievements verified from SAI, Bank details of the sportspersons should be forwarded to the Secretary H.P Sports Council.
- Screening committee: The Secretary, H.P Sports Council will constitute a screening committee to
 examine the authenticity of the distinctions achieved by sportspersons and their eligibility or
 otherwise for these Awards.
- 10. The Secretary, in accordance will the recommendations of the Awards Committee and with the approval of the President, H.P Sports Council, shall disburse the prizes out of Department / Council Funds.
- 11. These Award shall not be claimed as a matter of right and the decision of the Council shall be final and binding

12. General:-

- (i) The International sports competitions should have been conducted by the International sports body recognized by International Olympic Committee (IOC International Paralympic Committee (IPC) or organized by International Sports Federation for able-bodies sportspersons with the authorization of IPC, Olympic Council of Asia (OCA), World Chess Federation (FIDE), International Sports Committee for the Deaf (ICSD), International Blind Sports Federation (IBSA), Special Olympics International Billiards and Snooker Federation (IBSF).
- (ii) The Olympic Paralympics Asian Games, Para Asian Games and Commonwealth Games are fairly well defined sports events. However, there may be some ambiguity in determining as to which official World/ Asian /Commonwealth championship should be eligible for the Cash Award, as there may be many kinds of tournaments, cups or championships all organized officially but only one and the best of them may be listed as the official World/Asian/Commonwealth Championships in each eligible discipline for the purpose of these awards. The Government of India shall have the right on decide as to which event will be eligible for the cash award.

- (iii) With the approval of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of the state, suitable cash awards can be announced in very deserving cases for events not covered under the scheme.
- (iv) Amendment /Addition to the Rules:-

The council reserves the right to amend alter, delete or add to any of the preferences of these Rules at any time without assigning any reasons.
