1. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

Since Independence, harnessing the State's various rivers for power generation and irrigation has been the main focus of development activities in the State of Himachal Pradesh. This has resulted in the emergence of number of river valley projects with primary objectives of sorting river water for irrigation, power generation and other activities. One of the direct results of these projects is the creation of several manmade water bodies dotted virtually throughout the length and breadth in the state. The man-made lakes hold tremendous potential for inland fisheries development and offer ample scope for fish yield optimization through adoption of suitable management measures, recognized long back. Gobind Sagar, Chamera and Pong Dam are the major water bodies created and being harnessed for fish production. Another water body measuring 1300 hectare has emerged as a result of construction of Koldam on river Sutlej. The fishing activities in Koldam, Gobind Sagar, Chamera and Pong Dam provide full time direct and indirect vocation to over 6000 fishermen families mainly up rooted due to the completion of these river valley projects. Increased anthropogenic activities by way of construction of roads, setting up of large number of hydro-power projects, non release of regular environmental flow of water downstream weir dams, rampant rivers mining and dumping of muck and silt on river banks has resulted in declining trend in fish catches from the reservoirs. All this coupled with lack of seed production technology of hill stream fishes is becoming a cause of concern for fishermen families due to eroding of their fishing profession. Majority of fishermen are dam oustees who have lost their homes and hearths submerged in these manmade lakes. In order to arrest the downward trend in fish catches, some schemes have been formulated. To safeguard the interest of poor fishermen, Department of fisheries Himachal Pradesh is making whole hearted efforts to improve the socioeconomic status of these fishermen and to enhance fish production. However, the department is facing constraints in management of the fish co-operative societies to provide uniform price of fish caught to the fishermen members. Department on pilot basis is considering to take up a process of branding the fishes of Gobind Sagar Reservoir of the state by auctioning the fish rates through open tenders to a single contractor without disturbing the present system of capturing the fishes through co-operative societies license holder members. So, a proposal for modification in working of state reservoirs in Himachal Pradesh is hereby submitted which is envisaged to improve the conditions of reservoir fishermen.

2. <u>PROJECT AREA</u>

Initially, department proposes changes in the working of Gobind Sagar reservoir which came into existence due to damming of river Sutlej and has water spread of **16000** ha.

3. <u>PRESENT SYSTEM OF WORKING OF RESERVOIRS</u>

The reservoir fishermen are organized under Fisheries Cooperative Societies. Fish caught by fishermen is collected by the salesmen of the society and brought to fixed fish landing centers for handing over to the respective fish contractors of that society in the presence of fisheries officials. The contractors are made fully responsible for making payments to the fishermen at the rates fixed in the beginning of every year through open auction system at fisheries co-operative societies.

Number of fish cooperative societies in state reservoirs is as follows:

Department of Fisheries issues licenses to the reservoir fishermen @ Rs. 50/- annually for each gillnet of size 80x5 m with 5cm mesh size (*knot to knot*). Fish caught by the fishermen is brought to fixed landing centers where it is weighed in the presence of representatives of Fisheries Department, cooperative societies and that of contractors. The rates are fixed in the beginning of every year through open auction for summer (1st April to 30th September) and winter (1st October to 31st March) except close season w.e.f 1st june to 31st july. Department charges 15% royalty on the total sale proceeds of fish whereas cooperative societies after deducting 5-7% commission, makes the payment to the fishermen on weekly /10 days basis regularly. In this way, fishermen get 78-80% of cost of their catch.

To avoid conflict between the societies, regarding area of operation, reservoirs have been divided into beats demarcated on the basis of area and productivity of the water body.

4. <u>PROJECT RATIONALE:</u>

Fishery in Gobind Sagar reservoir was dominated by Indian and exotic carp. Increased siltation and human interference has resulted in depletion of breeding grounds of Silver Carp and Indian Major Carps, thus attributing mainly to downward trend of the catch. The fish caught by

fish co-operative societies is procured by different contractors within the reservoir leading to disparity in the prices of the same fish within a reservoir. So, to provide higher prices to the fishermen and to bring uniformity in the prices of fish within a reservoir a change in working of the reservoir is desired as proposed ahead. 50 percent of the fish caught shall be sold outside the state under a brand name to promote Himachal fish at a national level.

5. <u>OBJECTIVES:</u>

Project is being proposed with following objectives:-

- To bring uniformity in the prices of fish within a reservoir.
- To make fish of state reservoirs a brand.
- To increase income and improve socio-economic status of fisher community engaged in fishing in these reservoirs.

6. <u>IMPLEMENTATION PLAN:</u>

The procedure already in practice in the state for the purchase of material/other articles shall be adopted. Open online tenders shall be invited for purchase of fish of the whole reservoir by a single contractor and payment of fish catch will be made to fishermen through co-operative societies. The contractor has to make an agreement with all the fish cooperative societies of the reservoir for further implementation of the project. Fish contractor will also be made responsible for seed stocking every year of minimum Rs. 20.00 Lakh value in the reservoir as per the terms and conditions mentioned in the agreement during the tender. The cost of seed stocking shall be borne by the contractor. As small fry/fingerlings fall easy prey to predators so, Department proposes to stock advanced fingerlings above 70mm size in these reservoirs. So, fish seed stocking is the mainstay of development of fisheries in the reservoirs will also be addressed. Contractor will sell 50% of fish caught under an approved brand name and remaining 50% fish will be sold locally.

7. Venue & Deadline for submission of proposal:

Proposal, in its complete form in all respects as specified in the EOI, must be submitted to DoF, HP at the address specified herein earlier. In exceptional circumstances and at its discretion, DoF, HP may extend the deadline for submission of proposals by issuing an amendment to be made available on the DoF, HP website, in which case all rights and obligations of DoF, HP and the bidders previously subject to the original deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

8. Validity of Offer:

The offer for EOI as per this document shall be valid for a period of one year initially which may be extended further if required by DoF, HP.

12. Evaluation Criteria and Method of Evaluation:

- a. Screening of EOIs shall be carried out as per eligibility conditions mentioned in this document and based on verification of testimonials submitted.
- b. EOI will be evaluated for short listing inter alia based on their past experience of handling similar type of project, strength of their man power, financial strength of firm and presentation / proposal to the selection committee whose decision will be final.
- c. Agencies who qualify as per the eligibility conditions will be provided a brief about the project. The agencies may be required to make a presentation, if required, to a selection committee show-casing their proposals.
- d. DoF, HP will take up references and reserves the right to pay due heed to the Bidder's performance elsewhere and any past experience from DoF, HP.
- e. Short listed agencies will be issued Bid Documents and asked to submit their price proposal in a sealed envelope.
- f. Minimum base rate for fish purchase from Fish Co-operative Societies will be Rs. 120/- during Summer and Rs. 160/- during winter subject to revision by department from time to time.

13. Response:

14. Conflict of Interest:

- Secretary(Fisheries), HP will be the final arbitrator in cases of potential conflicts of interest. Failure to notify DoF, HP of any potential conflict of interest will invalidate any verbal or written agreement.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. PROJECT AREA

Initially Govind Sagar reservoir water spread of **16000** ha. will be taken up for modification in working. Fish production of last three years of the Govind Sagar reservoir is as per detail given below:

2. <u>OBJECTIVES</u>

(i) The main focus of this initiative is to uplift the life standard of poor fishermen engaged in the occupation of fishing in the state by way of providing them a reasonable rate of fish capture.

- (ii) The objective of the modification in working of state reservoirs is
 - To bring uniformity in the prices of fish within a reservoir.
 - To make fish of state reservoirs a brand.
 - To increase income and improve socio-economic status of fisher community engaged in fishing in these reservoirs.

3. <u>REQUISITES OF THE ORGANIZATION/FIRM/COMPANY/ PARTNERSHIP FIRM</u>

- (a) The Organization/Firm/Company/ Partnership Firm would be required to facilitate a consultative and participatory process with various stakeholders, generate knowledge products to manage capacity building activities.
- (b) This Organization/Firm/Company/ Partnership Firm would periodically require intensive time commitment to prepare and facilitate capacity building events. It will also require a permanent time commitment to ensure that information and communication happens on a continuous basis.
- (c) The Organization/Firm/Company/ Partnership Firm would sign agreements with the fish cooperative societies of the reservoirs.
- (d) This being a strategic policy area it is expected that the selected firm displays a high level of professionalism and is able to maintain its highly qualified team over the entire project period, unless changes are requested and agreed to by the Department.

4. <u>TIME SCHEDULE</u>

Work should be executed with in 3 months after obtaining the administrative approval other wise it stands cancelled.

5. INPUTS TO BE PROVIDED/CHECK WILL BE INFORCED BY DoF, HP

DoF, HP will facilitate interaction of Organization/Firm/Company/ Partnership Firm with the officers as well as their visits to the other reservoirs of the state. If required, a representative of DoF, HP would accompany the team during the visit to other reservoirs of the state. Besides, this department will also ensure the checks on following points:-

- i) Out of total available fish produce 50% have to be supplied to the local markets as per the rates fixed by the department and remaining 50% produce should be kept by firm on his own disposal for sale under approved brand name. However, the selling price of fish will not be more than 30% of the buying price.
- ii) Rates for local market should not exceed 30% of approved fish sale price.
- iii) Department will charge 15% as Royalty Charges on the prevailing practice in the department.
- iv) Society commission value (5 to7%)
- v) Marketing fee (1%)

6. <u>DELIVERABLES</u>

The Organization/Firm/Company/ Partnership Firm shall submit a detailed report indicating the following:

- (i) Signing of agreements with the various fish cooperative societies of the reservoir.
- (ii) Status of implementation of modification in working of state reservoirs in Himachal Pradesh.
- (iii) Status of achievement of desired outputs and outcomes under modification in working of state reservoirs.
- (iv) Recommendations on further improvement of modification in working of state reservoirs with objective of meeting its targets.
- (v) Present problem for implementation of modification in working of state reservoirs.
- (vi) The cold storage of capacity at least 20 Ton must be installed.
- (vii) Present prevailing fish capture system should not be disturbed and will remain as it is.
- (viii) Working Capital Certificate/Statement from Bank clearly mentioning the name of Organization/Firm/Company/ Partnership Firm.
- (ix) Fisheries Rules /Acts -1979 be adhere strictly.
- (x) Fish Seed at least Rs. 20.00 Lac only should have mandatorily been stocked by the firm every year in the reservoir.
