Recruitment and promotion rules for the post of Superintendent Grade-III, Class-III (Non-Gazetted) in the Department of Fisheries, Himachal Pradesh.

DESIRABLE:

Knowledge of customs, manners and dialects of Himachal Pradesh and suitability of appointment in the peculiar conditions prevailing in the Pradesh.

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| 8. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotion. | No. |
| 9. Period of probation, if any. | Two years subject to such further extension for a period not |

exceeding one year as may be ordered by the competent authority in special circumstances and for reasons to be reduced to writing.

10. Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion, deputation/transfer and percentage of vacancies to be filled by various methods.

100% by promotion, failing which by direct recruitment.

11. In case of recruitment by promotion, deputation/transfer, grades from which promotions, deputation/transfer to be made.

By Promotion from amongst:
Accountants/Assistants/Senior Scale Stenographer with atleast five years regular or adhoc (rendered upto 31st December, 1983) service in the respective grades.

(For purpose of promotion a combined seniority list of eligible officials will be prepared based on the length of regular service in the respective grades:).

12. If a DFC exists, what is its composition.

As may be constituted by the Government from time to time.

13. Circumstances under which the H.P. Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitments.

As required under the law.

14. Relaxation Clause.

Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by orders, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the H.P. Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any Class or category of persons or post.

15. A candidate for appointment to any service or post must be:-
- (a) A citizen of India, or
 - (b) A subject of Nepal, Or
 - (c) A subject of Bhutan, Or
 - (d) a Tibetan refugee who come over to India before the 1st January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India, Or
 - (e) A person of Indian Origin, who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (Formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar) Zambia, Malawi, Zaire and Ethiopia with the intention of permanently settling in India;

provided that a candidate belonging to categories (b) (c), (d) and (e) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Govt. of India/State Govt.

A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to an examination or interview conducted by the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission or other recruiting authority, but the offer of appointment shall be given only after the necessary eligibility certificate has been issued to him by the Govt. of India/Govt. of Himachal Pradesh.

- 16. Upper age limit for direct recruits will not be applicable to the candidates already in service of the Govt.
- 17. Upper age-limit is relaxable for Sch. Castes/Sch. Tribes candidates and certain other categories of persons to the extent permissible under the general or special orders of the Himachal Pradesh Govt.
- 18. Age limit for direct recruits will be reckoned from the last date fixed for receipt of applications/receipt of lists of eligible candidates from Employment exchanges by the Commission.
- 19. Age and experience for the direct recruits relaxable at the discretion of the Commission in the case of candidate otherwise well qualified.
- 20. Provisions of Columns 10 and 11 are to be revised by the Govt. in consultation with the Commission as and when the No. of posts under Column 2 is increased or decreased.
- 21. Selection for appointment to these posts in the case of direct recruitment shall be made on the basis of a Viva Voce test, if the Commission so considers necessary expedient, by a written test, the standard/syllabus etc. or which will be determined by the Commission or a practical test.

22. In all cases where a junior person becomes eligible for consideration by virtue of his total length of service (including adhoc one rendered upto 31-12-83) in the feeder post, all persons senior to him in respective categories shall be deemed to be eligible for consideration and placed above the junior persons in the field of consideration.

provided that all incumbents to be considered for promotion/confirmation shall possess the minimum qualifying service of at least three years or that prescribed in the relevant recruitment and promotion rules for the post whichever is less,

provided further that where a person becomes eligible to be considered for promotion/confirmation on account of the requirement prescribed in the preceding proviso, the person(s) junior to him shall also be deemed to be ineligible for consideration for such promotion/Confirmation.

23. The employees of all the public sectors/Corporations and Autonomous Bodies who happened to be Govt. Servants before absorption in the public Sector/Corporation/Autonomous Bodies at the time of initial constitution of such Corporation/Autonomous Bodies shall be allowed age concession in direct recruitment as admissible to Govt. servants. This concession will not, however, be admissible to such staff of the public Sector/Corporations/Autonomous Bodies who were/are subsequently appointed by such Corporations/Autonomous Bodies who were/are subsequently appointed by such Corporations/Autonomous Bodies and are/were finally absorbed in the service of such Corporations/Autonomous Bodies after the initial constitution of the public Sector Corporations/Autonomous Bodies.
24. The appointment to the service shall be subject to orders/ regarding reservation in the service for Sch. Castes/Sch. Tribes/Backward Classes etc. issued by the Himachal Pradesh Govt. from time to time.
