ORDER

WHEREAS, it has been gathered that there are a large number of Himachali students, travellers, pilgrims, professionals who are currently stranded outside Himachal Pradesh in different States /UTs due to the 'lockdown' and restrictions on inter-State movement currently in force due to spread of the COVID-19. Likewise, there are many persons belonging to other States/UTs who are presently staying in different parts of Himachal Pradesh as students/ tourists/ business travellers/professionals/industrial workers etc. and are desirous to go back to their respective native States/ UTs.

WHEREAS, the Government of India, M/o Home Affairs, New Delhi vide Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 29th April, 2020 has allowed movement of persons across State borders. Hence it is expedient to have coordination with respective States/UT Governments to ensure smooth, staggered and orderly movement of persons between Himachal Pradesh and other States/UTs in public interest.

WHEREAS, Shri Onkar Chand Sharma, IAS (HP:1994) (Contact Number:94182-30009), FC-cum-Principal Secretary (Revenue-DMC) and Principal Secretary (Tribal Development & Agriculture) to the Government of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla has been designated as the State Nodal Officer vide Order No. Rev(DMC)(C)20-2/2020-COVID-19 dated 30th April, 2020 and it has been further directed that Department of Personnel shall immediately appoint adequate number of supporting officers to the Nodal Authority to help him coordinate movement of the migrant workers, pilgrims, tourists, students and other persons both within and outside the State.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me under Clause 3 of the H.P. Epidemic Disease (COVID-19) Amendment Regulations, 2020, Shri Yunus, IAS (HP:2010), (Contact Number:88940-35375), Director, Tourism & Civil Aviation, Himachal Pradesh and Managing Director, H.R.T.C., Shimla, is hereby designated as the State Joint Nodal Officer for the purpose.
