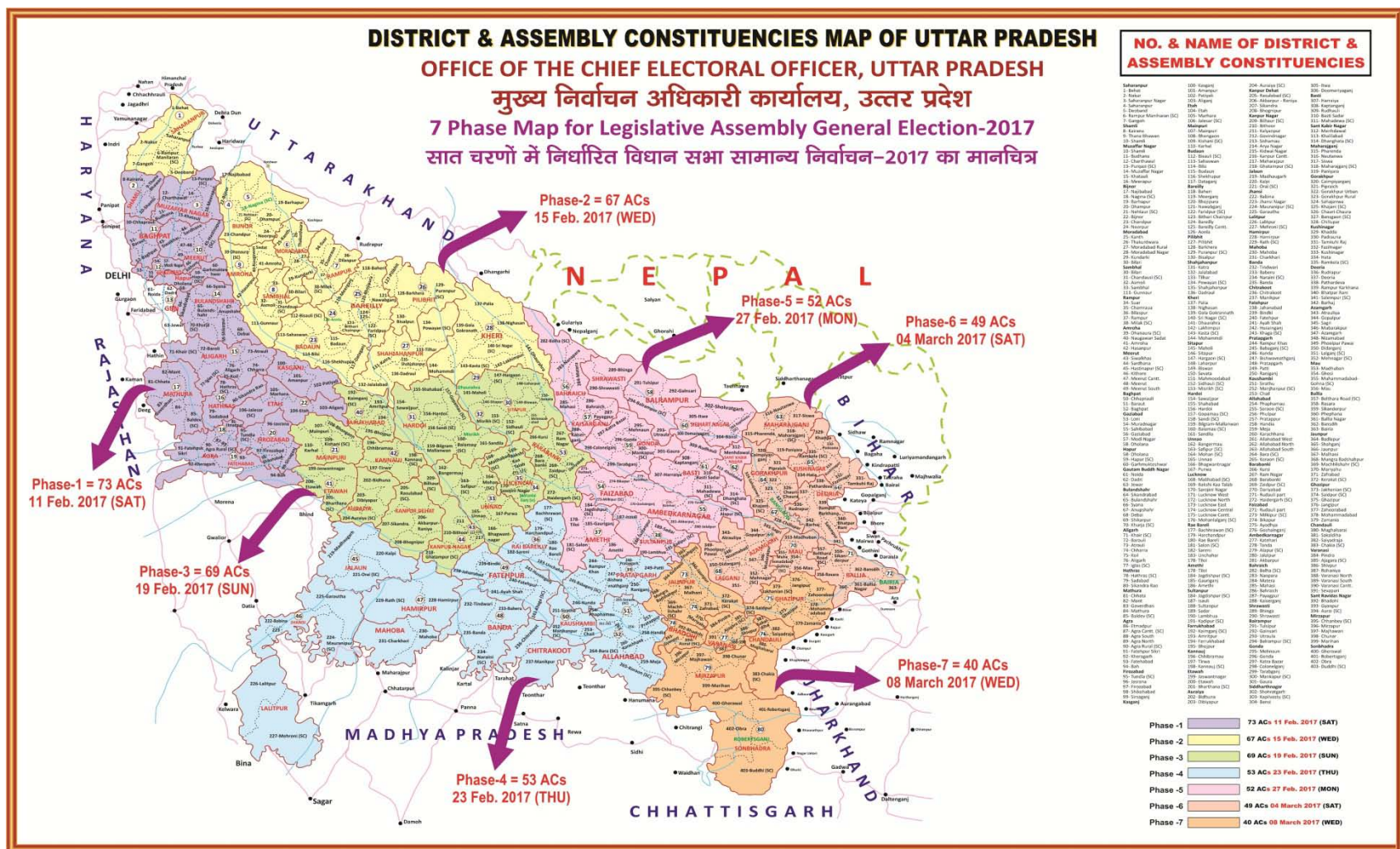

# Pre-Poll Preparations

- **Preparation of various plans** e.g. Communication Plan, Training Plan, Tentative state deployment plan etc.
- **Preparation of atmosphere conducive for peaceful, free and fair polls** e.g. Special Drive against criminals, Meetings with border states, Strict monitoring of the L&O and crime scene of state, Transfer & Postings of officials, Vulnerability Mapping and Critical Polling Station identification exercise and mitigation etc.

# TRANSFERS/POSTING OF OFFICERS (LAE- 2017)

- ECI's Direction dated 07-09-2016 wrt to the General Elections to the State Legislative Assembly of UP – Transfer/Posting of officers.
  - (1) No officer connected directly with elections shall be allowed to continue in the present district of posting:-
    - (a) if she/he is posted in her/his home district.
    - (b) If she/he has completed 3 years in that district during last 4 years or would be completing 3 years on or before 31-05-2017 in case of UP
      - (i) No police Inspectors/Sub Inspectors or above is posted back or allowed to continue in the AC/district where he/she was posted in last Assembly election/any bye election held thereafter.

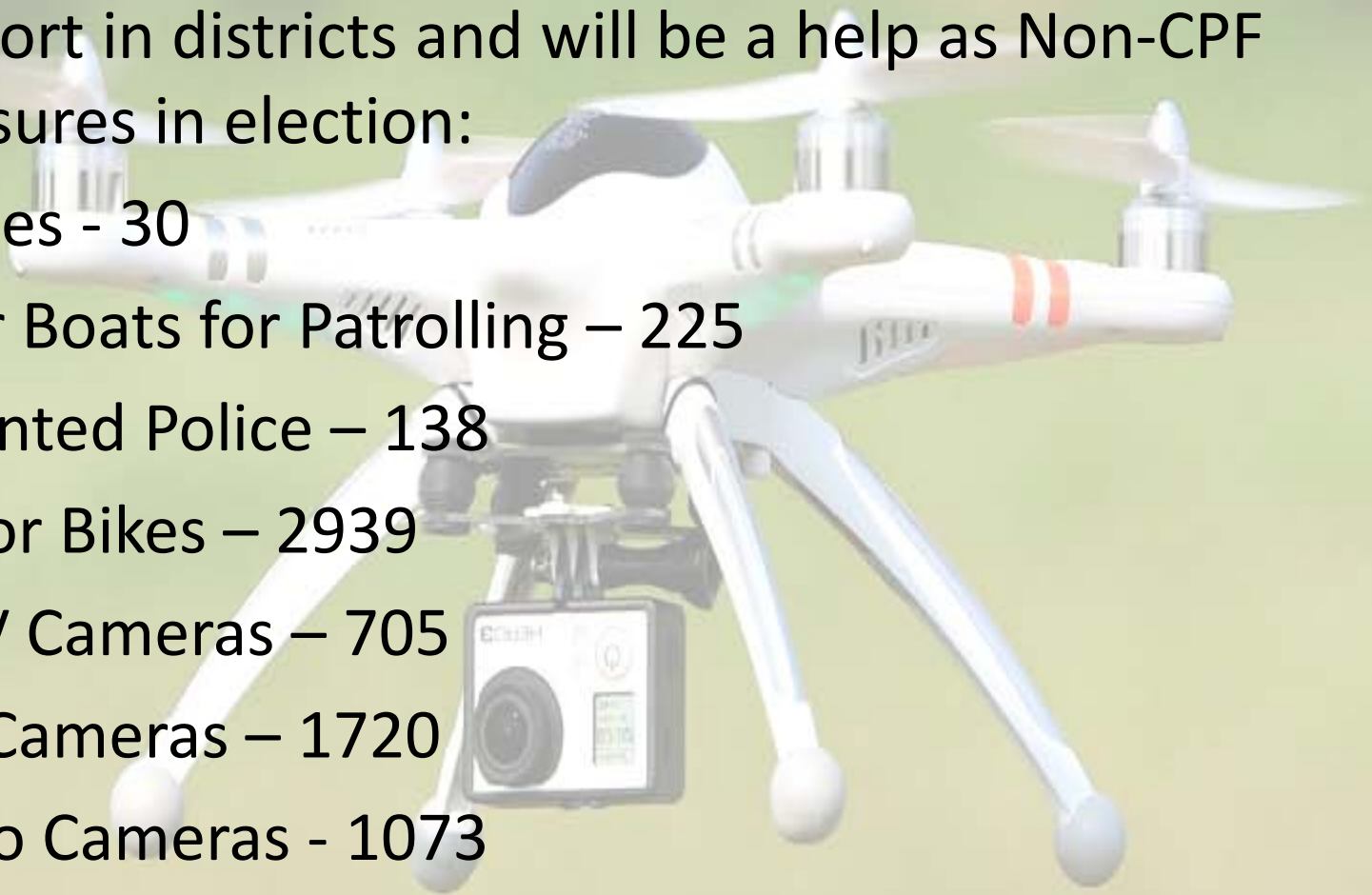
