Subject: Regarding issue termination order from the services against those Government employees, who were involved in narcotic related offences.

Sir,

It is in reference to the Government letter No. EDN-A-Kha(1)12/2021 dated 14-05-2026 (*copy enclosed*) on the subject cited above.

In this regard, it is intimated that the State Government has decided to terminate the services of those employees who are found involved in drug-related offences and therefore, the Secretary (Education) to the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh has directed vide above mentioned letter, to examine such cases under Article 311(2)(b) of the Constitution of India and the provisions of the NDPS Act, 1985, in the light of above decision of the Government. Therefore, the matter regarding examination of cases of such employees, who have been found involved in drug-related offences, are to be processed/ decided by the Department. However, to proceed further in the matter, the following detail in r/o the person (as mentioned in the table below/ received in this Directorate), is not sufficient:-

Subject: Regarding issue termination order from the services against those Government employees, who were involved in narcotic related offences.


Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to inform you that a recent meeting of the NCORD (National Coordination on Drug Enforcement) was chaired by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Himachal Pradesh, wherein the State Government expressed grave concern over the increasing incidents of "Chitta"/drug trafficking and consumption in the State.

In order to curb the spread of narcotics among the youth, restore public confidence in the administration, and in furtherance of the State's Zero-Tolerance Policy against "Chitta"/drugs, and in pursuance of the resolve expressed by the Hon'ble Chief Minister to cleanse the Government machinery of individuals associated with narcotics trade, the State Government has decided to terminate the services of those employees who are found involved in drug-related offences.

You are, therefore, requested to examine the cases annexed as Annexure-"A" and Annexure-"B" under Article 311(2)(b) of the Constitution of India and the provisions of the NDPS Act, 1985, in light of the above decision of the Government, at the earliest.
