TERMS AND CONDITIONS: -

- i. The engagement of the Music Teacher shall be considered to be made under the provisions of the "Scheme for the Engagement of Teachers in Government Schools Affiliated to Central Board Of Secondary Education (CBSE) on "Fixed Honorarium/Consolidated Amount", notified vide No. EDN-B-A(1)-3/2025 dated 01st April, 2026 by the Government.

- ii. The teachers are engaged temporarily for a fixed period of five (5) years and they shall be paid monthly Consolidated Fixed Honorarium/Amount@ ₹30,000/- per month, only for a period of ten (10) months in an academic year, subject to such enhancement as may be approved by the Government from time to time.
- iii. The Music Teacher engaged shall have to execute and furnish an Agreement/Bond and Self Declaration, as per the Sub-Scheme on the enclosed format Annexure-A at the time of joining in the office of the Head of the Institution.
- iv. The Teachers temporarily engaged under the Sub-Scheme shall not be deemed to be Government employee in any manner and shall be governed by the terms and condition of the Sub-Scheme only and an agreement/bond executed in this regard. Any benefit available to Government employees appointed on regular basis shall not be extended to the teachers engaged under this Sub-Scheme.
- v. These engaged teachers are liable to be posted/deputed further in any Government Schools, as per the requirement of the Education Department.
- vi. These teachers shall teach Music subject from Middle Stage to Senior Secondary Level (*i.e. from Class VI to Class XII*) and shall also take additional remedial classes, as and when directed by Head of the Institution.
- vii. If, at any stage, it is found that the person engaged under the Sub-Scheme does not fulfill criteria for the post or is otherwise ineligible, the person shall be removed from service/engagement, in accordance with Sub-Scheme/Agreement, after issuing prior notice.
- viii. In the event of dereliction of duty, misbehavior, embezzlement, any criminal offence, moral turpitude and involvement in sexual harassment at work place etc. or any other misconduct, the teachers engaged under the Sub-Scheme shall be terminated by following the Principles of Natural Justice by competent authority. The criminal proceedings shall also be initiated against the teacher in accordance with law.
- ix. Teachers engaged under the Sub-Scheme will be entitled for TA/DA, for tours in connection with his/her official duties, as assigned by the Head of the Institution, at the rate as prescribed by the State Government from time to time.
- x. Teachers engaged under the Sub-Scheme shall have to perform such duties as directed by their Controlling Officers (Principal) or higher authorities; any violation shall amount to termination of engagement/agreement after giving reasonable opportunity of hearing.
- xi. The teachers engaged under the Sub-Scheme shall be eligible for Medical benefit Schemes under HIMCARE/Ayushman Bharat, as applicable and such persons shall become the member of the Scheme. The Government medical rules for reimbursement claims shall not be applicable to such teachers.

- xii. Engagement under the Sub-Scheme shall not confer any right, claim or preference whatsoever for regular appointment in future. In event the Government, at any Stage, decides to undertake regular recruitment against vacant sanctioned posts, such engaged teachers shall be required to participate in and qualify the prescribed selection process or examination applicable to such posts, as may be notified by the Government.
- xiii. The teachers engaged under the Sub-Scheme shall be entitled for ten (10) Casual Leaves in a year and Maternity Leave as admissible under the Maternity Benefits Act, 1961.
- xiv. The service Rule (*including CCS/CCA/Leave Rules/Pension Rule or any other rules as applicable to Government servants*) shall not be applicable to the teachers engaged under the Sub-Scheme. The period of engagement under this Sub-Scheme shall not be counted for any purpose/service benefits and teachers shall be entitled only for the benefits as mentioned in the Sub-Scheme.
- xv. Teachers engaged under the Sub-Scheme shall have no right to claim regularization or appointment against any vacant sanctioned post. Engagement under the Sub-Scheme shall not confer any right, title or interest for absorption in Government service and no such claim shall be entertained at any Stage.
- xvi. Teachers engaged under the Sub-Scheme shall also function as substitute teachers during the leave period of any teacher or against any vacant post as and when so required.
- xvii. The Head of the Institution shall assign teaching duties in respect of any teacher who proceeds on leave, deputation, or is otherwise unavailable. Such teachers may also be deputed to primary Schools or to any School within the cluster, or, where required, to nearby Government Schools outside the cluster for short durations, in order to support improvement in the learning levels of Students.
- xviii. The engagement can be discontinued at any stage in accordance with the Sub-Scheme/Agreement and shall be automatically cease upon expiry of the prescribed period of five (5) years, unless specifically extended by the Government.
- xix. Any subsequent conditions/provisions of the Sub-Scheme/policy of Music Teachers, issued by the Government/Department from time to time shall also be governed the service conditions of these engaged Music Teachers.

If this offer of engagement on the above terms & conditions is acceptable to the candidate (s), he/she may report for duty within (5) five working days, failing which his or her engagement shall stand cancelled automatically and no further correspondence shall be entertained in this behalf. Further before joining of duties, he/she is required to execute Agreement/bond and Self Declaration on the Stamp Paper and to submit certificate to his/her medical fitness from a Government/Registered

Medical Practitioner and shall require to submit all above documents to the Head of the Institution at the time of joining.

However, due diligence has been exercised by the Himachal Pradesh Rajya Chayan Aayog (HPRCA) and this Directorate while scrutinizing the documents of the selected candidates. **Nevertheless, the Principals concerned shall also verify the original documents and testimonials of the candidates especially EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS in view of the provisions of the Sub-Scheme and clarifications issued by Government/Directorate in this regard and ensure that proper records thereof are maintained in their respective offices. In case of any discrepancy, deficiency, or concealment of facts noticed during such verification, the matter shall be reported to this Directorate immediately for further necessary action.**

The engagement shall be considered provisional till the verification of character and antecedents, which will be carried out on the basis of self-declaration form (**Copy enclosed**) submitted by the candidate at the time of joining of duties, certifying therein that all facts and detail given are correct. In case, character and antecedents of the candidates are not found verified or any false information is given by the candidates in self-declaration, the provisional engagement will be cancelled forthwith and criminal legal action will be taken as a consequence.

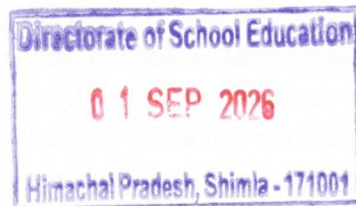

ANNEXURE-A

Agreement to be executed between the Music Teacher and the Government of Himachal Pradesh through Director of School Education/Head of Institution under a "Scheme for the Engagement of Teachers in Government Schools Affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) On "Fixed Honorarium/Consolidated Amount"".

This Agreement is executed on this ____ day of _____, 20 ____ at _____.

Between

The Governor of Himachal Pradesh through the Director of School Education, Himachal Pradesh, hereinafter referred to as the Department and FIRST PARTY, which expression shall include its successors,

And

Sh./Smt./Ms. _____

S/o/D/o/W/o _____

_____, resident of _____,
Designation _____ hereinafter referred to as the Teacher and
SECOND PARTY.

Whereas, the FIRST PARTY has engaged the aforesaid SECOND PARTY as a Music Teacher and SECOND PARTY has agreed to the same, on following terms & conditions: -

1. The engagement of the Music Teacher shall be purely temporary in nature and shall not be construed as an appointment against any sanctioned post under the Government.
2. The Teacher shall not be deemed to be a Government servant and shall not be entitled to any benefits, privileges or protections admissible to regular Government employees.
3. The Teacher shall be engaged for a period of five years from the date of joining, subject to satisfactory performance, conduct and compliances of the provisions of this Agreement and the Sub-Scheme notified by the Government from time to time.
4. The engagement may be discontinued at any stage in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement and the Sub-Scheme. It shall automatically cease upon expiry of the prescribed period of five years, unless specifically extended by the Government.
5. The Teacher may be posted in any Government School affiliated to CBSE and shall be liable for transfer, further deputation or temporary assignment to any School or institution as determined by the Department in the interest of students and effective School functioning.
6. The Teacher may be assigned substitute teaching duties against vacant positions, during the absence of regular teachers, or any other academic responsibilities, including teaching subjects/classes consistent with his/her qualifications and competence.
7. The Teacher shall be paid a fixed monthly honorarium or consolidated remuneration of ₹30,000 per month for ten months in a given academic year, as notified by the Government from time to time. Such honorarium shall not be treated as pay, salary or wages and shall not confer entitlement to any service benefits or allowances except those

- specifically provided under the provisions of the Sub-Scheme; however, TA/DA for official duties shall be admissible as per Government norms.
8. The Teacher shall faithfully perform all academic, co-curricular and institutional duties assigned by the Head of Institution or any competent authority and shall adopt competency-based, student-centric teaching practices in accordance with the CBSE curriculum, National Education Policy (NEP)-2020 and instructions issued by the Government from time to time.
 9. These teachers shall teach Music subject from Middle Stage to Senior Secondary Level (i.e from Class VI to Class XII) and shall also take additional remedial classes, as and when directed by Head of the Institution.
 10. The Teacher shall also ensure timely completion of given assignment/syllabus, conduct assessments and maintain all prescribed academic records.
 11. The Teacher shall maintain discipline; punctuality and professional conduct and participate in training programmes, meetings and School activities and undertake extra classes, remedial teaching or any other academic assignments as required.
 12. The Teacher shall not engage in private tuition, coaching or any other employment or gainful activity during his/her engagement under the Sub Scheme.
 13. The performance of the Teacher shall be assessed periodically on the basis of academic outcomes, professional conduct, attendance and overall contribution towards School functioning. Unsatisfactory performance may result in discontinuation of engagement in accordance with the provisions of the Scheme and this Agreement.
 14. The Teacher shall be entitled to ten days Casual Leave in a calendar year and Maternity Leave, as admissible under Maternity Benefits Acts, 1961 and further may avail benefits under HIMCARE, Ayushman Bharat or any other welfare scheme, if applicable to such persons engaged under similarly situated schemes of the Government.
 15. The Government medical rules for reimbursement claims shall not be applicable to such teachers. Other service benefits of GPF, EPF, Pension or Employee Group Insurance Scheme shall also not be admissible and apply to the teachers.
 16. The Teacher shall maintain integrity, devotion to duty and professional ethics at all times. Any misconduct, negligence, insubordination, criminal offence, moral turpitude or violation of the terms of engagement shall render the Teacher liable to disciplinary action, including termination of engagement, after following the principles of natural justice.
 17. The engagement may be terminated by the Department at any time in administrative interest or for violation of the provisions of the Scheme, terms of this Agreement, misconduct, ineligibility, and suppression of facts or furnishing of false information.
 18. The Teacher may resign from the engagement by giving one month's prior notice or such notice as may be prescribed by the Government.
 19. The Teacher shall have no right to claim regularization, absorption, continuation or appointment against any sanctioned post under the Government.
 20. This engagement shall not confer any right, title or claim to Government service on regular basis and in the event of regular recruitment, the

Teacher shall be required to participate in and qualify the prescribed selection process without any preference or relaxation unless specifically provided by the Government.

21. The Teacher shall be governed by the provisions of the Sub-Scheme and instructions issued by the Government from time to time and the service rules applicable to regular Government employees shall not apply.
22. The Teacher shall maintain confidentiality of all official records and information and any breach thereof shall be treated as misconduct.
23. The Teacher shall faithfully discharge assigned duties and shall not be entitled to claim any compensation or benefit beyond the admissible honorarium.
24. The Department reserves the right to modify the terms of engagement in public interest and the Teacher shall comply with all lawful orders issued by the competent authority.
25. Any dispute arising out of this Agreement shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the competent courts in Himachal Pradesh.
