The duly completed application/nomination alongwith the requisite supporting documents should be submitted online through the dedicated Email ID: teachersawarddsehp@gmail.com on or before **08th August, 2026**. Applications received after the prescribed deadline or found incomplete in any respect shall not be considered.

The detailed scheme is enclosed herewith. Further instructions, if any, shall be issued separately by the Directorate in due course of time. All eligible teachers, Headmasters and Principals are requested to submit their applications/nominations within the stipulated time. 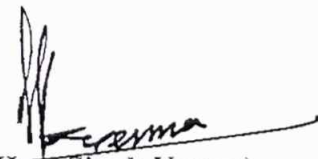

HIMACHAL PRADESH STATE AWARD FOR SCHOOL TEACHERS SCHEME, 2026

INTRODUCTION

The Government of Himachal Pradesh has been implementing a scheme of "State Award to teachers and Heads of the School" since long time back. The State Awards to teachers are given by the Hon'ble Governor of Himachal Pradesh on 5th September (Teachers' Day) every year. Its main objective is to raise the prestige of teaching profession in society and to give recognition to services rendered by teachers of outstanding merit and ability. This scheme is applicable to the teachers who are serving in Government Primary/Middle/High/Senior Secondary Schools in Himachal Pradesh.

However, the review of the present scheme was considered necessary to strengthen teacher effectiveness, improve learning outcomes, address emerging educational challenges and ensure successful implementation of educational reforms. The implementation of NEP 2020 emphasizes competency based learning and digital education. Therefore, a well-reviewed scheme can contribute significantly to a more equitable and high-quality education system. It also recognizes and encourages the role of teachers in achieving key parameters of the priority areas of Government for quality improvement initiatives such as implementation of School Complex System/Cluster System and Resource Sharing, Adoption of School Programme, Smart Uniform, Reading Room, Libraries etc.

Thus, the new scheme has been prepared to reduce the subjectivity and give more emphasis on the learning outcomes, other quantifiable indicators and to encourage the innovation in the field of education.

The number of awards has been fixed as 25. The teachers who are serving in General and Tribal/Hard Area would be awarded separately. The Awards for the teachers serving in General area will be sixteen (16) & for Tribal/Hard Area will be Nine (09).

In addition to the above 25 State Teacher Awards, Government has decided to give **6 SPECIAL AWARDS** to outstanding/exceptional teachers in the State for their extraordinary contribution towards innovation, for implementing flagship programmes of the State Government and also for special initiatives which may change on yearly basis. Teachers' contribution will be recognized by the Government and the names will be finalized as per the recommendation of "State Level Committee" constituted under "State Teachers' Award Scheme".

Each State Awardee will receive a Memento, a Medal, Himachali Cap/Scarf, Shawl, a book, a citation, a certificate and/or any other item as may be decided by the State Level Committee.

1. OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHEME:

- 1.1 To achieve excellence in the field of education.
 - 1.2 To promote recognition, respect and appreciation of the teachers.
 - 1.3 To stimulate interest in teaching as a career.
 - 1.4 To provide incentive and motivation to teachers to put extra efforts in the field of education.
 - 1.5 To motivate quality teaching and desire to have a good reputation in the community.
 - 1.6 To honour dedicated, deserving, creative and effective teachers.
 - 1.7 To encourage best practices in schools.

Note: In General Area

- 1) In TGTs category one award will be given under each stream i.e. one for Medical, one for Non-Medical and one for TGT Arts.
- 2) In PGTs/Lecturer category one award will be given under each stream i.e. one for Sciences (including Maths), one for Commerce (including Economics) and one for Arts Stream.

3. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR APPLYING FOR THE STATE TEACHER AWARD

- 3.1 **TEACHING EXPERIENCE:** Teachers with at least five years teaching experience (Regular/Trainee/Job Trainee/SMC/Contract/Any other mode of appointment) and Two years of administrative experience in case of Headmaster/Principal who are actually working in Government Primary/Middle/High/Senior Secondary Schools in Himachal Pradesh, as the case may be, shall be eligible to apply. For the purpose of this

clause, the cut-off date shall be 31st March of the current year. Any experience outside the Department of Education shall not be counted.

- 3.2 Normally retired teachers are not eligible for the award. However, teachers who have served upto 31st March of the current year fulfilling all other eligibility conditions may be considered. Services rendered on re-employment after superannuation shall not be counted for eligibility criteria. Teachers whose names were recommended earlier but did not receive the award, may be considered again, subject to the continued eligibility.
- 3.3 Educational Administrators (Except Principal/Headmaster) and the staff of training colleges are not eligible for these awards. However, under the **“SPECIAL AWARDS”** category, teachers posted in DIETs/SCERT/Samagra Shiksha shall also be eligible.
- 3.4 All teachers holding non-teaching jobs in the Department of School Education are ineligible for the award.
- 3.5 Any teacher with grade below “GOOD” in any of his ACRs for the last five years shall not be eligible.
- 3.6 **Every application/nomination shall be submitted in online mode to the Directorate of School Education, (H.P.) on prescribed format. The VSK Cell of SPD Office shall provide technical support and shall develop a special portal for this purpose.** The application shall include relevant documents only as may be prescribed by the Director of School Education separately. Unnecessary and irrelevant documents shall be avoided.
- 3.7 **Undertaking by the applicant:** Each applicant shall give an undertaking that all the information/data submitted is true to the best of his/her knowledge and if anything is found at any later date to be untrue then he/she will be liable to disciplinary action.
- 3.8 **ELIGIBILITY IN TERMS OF ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE:** For service in High/Senior Secondary School: In respect of the board class taught/the schools served by the teacher(s)/HM/Principal for more than 6 months in the last 3 years, the pass percentage of students in any of these last three years in the concerned subject (in case of teachers) and in board class(es) (in case of HM and Principal) should not be less than the overall pass percentage of the board in that subject/Class(es).
- 3.9 **DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS:** Any teacher who has been penalized for misconduct under major/minor penalty under CCA Rules 14/16 over the previous five years shall not be eligible to apply for the State Teacher Award.
- 3.10 State Teachers' Award will be given only once in service.

- 3.11 Any teacher involved in **frivolous litigation** against the Department/State shall not be eligible.
- 3.12 The award under Hard/Tribal Area Category will be given to teachers:
- (a) Whose 50% service is in the Rural Area. Out of this, at least one tenure (two and a half years of service) should be in tribal/hard area.
 - (b) Who is presently serving in Hard/Tribal Area.

4. PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION AND SELECTION FOR STATE AWARD

- 4.1 The teacher will apply on the prescribed Performa to the Directorate of School Education directly/through concerned controlling officer in online mode, w.e.f. 16th July to 30th July or as per the schedule fixed by the Director of School Education. Apart from self-nomination, the name of any teacher can also be nominated by someone else (DC/ADC/ADM/SDM, the school, the SMC, NGO, community organization, any other teacher or any other member of the public). The Directorate Level Committee will scrutinize the documents of the applicants for eligibility and will verify the same by 5th of August. *However, the Director, School Education, H.P. may modify these timelines as per the requirements on year to year basis.*

- 4.2 The selection procedure would have three steps:

STEP 1: Verification of eligibility: Verification of eligibility shall be done by the Directorate Level Scrutiny Committee.

STEP 2 : Short listing of Teachers: Short listing of the nominations shall be done by the Directorate Level Short listing Committee after evaluation of each candidate on the basis of the objective criteria prescribed for each category of teacher in case of General Award and on the basis of Presentation in case of Special Awards. The Directorate Level Short Listing Committee will forward confidentially NOMINATIONS (at least Twice and at the most Thrice the no of awards to be given under each category) to the State Level Selection Committee. While finalizing the nominations, the Directorate Level Committee shall ensure that as far as practically feasible, all the Districts are represented in the shortlist.

STEP 3: Selection of Teachers for the Award: The shortlisted teachers will be called for Presentation and Interaction with the State Level Committee and final selection of the teachers for the awards shall be made by the said committee.

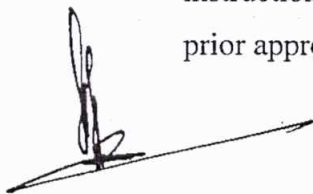
➤ *No person who has been nominated for award or who has nominated someone for award shall be a member of any of these Committees.*

6. Withdrawal of the Awards under Special Circumstances: The State gives awards to honour teachers/school heads to enhance their dignity and prestige in the society and depict them as exemplary and model teachers/school heads/administrators to be paragon of virtue for other teachers for motivation. However, when instances of some malpractice or bad activities by an awardee come to notice, it brings disgrace not only to the Department but also to the whole teacher community. Hence, in this backdrop following general conditions are laid down for awardees:

- i. If any awardee who is bestowed with the Award tries to degrade the prestige of award, gives any statement to return the award in any sort of resentment, his/her award will be taken back and he/she will be permanently debarred from applying for award in the future.
- ii. In case the result of the awardee's is less than the average results of the state (H.P. Board results or results of any other test e.g. NAS or any other test to be specified by the Department) in any of the following years, his/her Award will be taken back after giving an opportunity of being heard.
- iii. It is further stated that if any awardee is found to be involved in any immoral activity or using derogatory remarks or language against their colleagues/head/senior officer or as the case may be decided by Department, in that case his/her award should be taken back apart from initiating appropriate departmental action against him/her.
- iv. If a teacher has received the State Award but subsequently gets penalized under CCS(CCA) Rules, 1965 for misconduct in public service or otherwise or criminal case filed against the awardee, his/her Award shall be taken back.

7. POWER TO ISSUE INSTRUCTIONS/GUIDELINES/CLARIFICATIONS ETC.

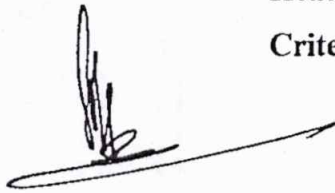
The Director, School Education shall be competent to issue instructions/guidelines/clarifications etc. for smooth implementation of the scheme, after prior approval of Secretary (Education) to the Government of Himachal Pradesh.



8. POWER TO RELAX: Where the Secretary (Education) to the Govt of HP is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of the scheme with respect to any category of awards.

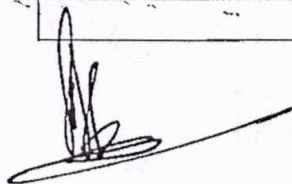
